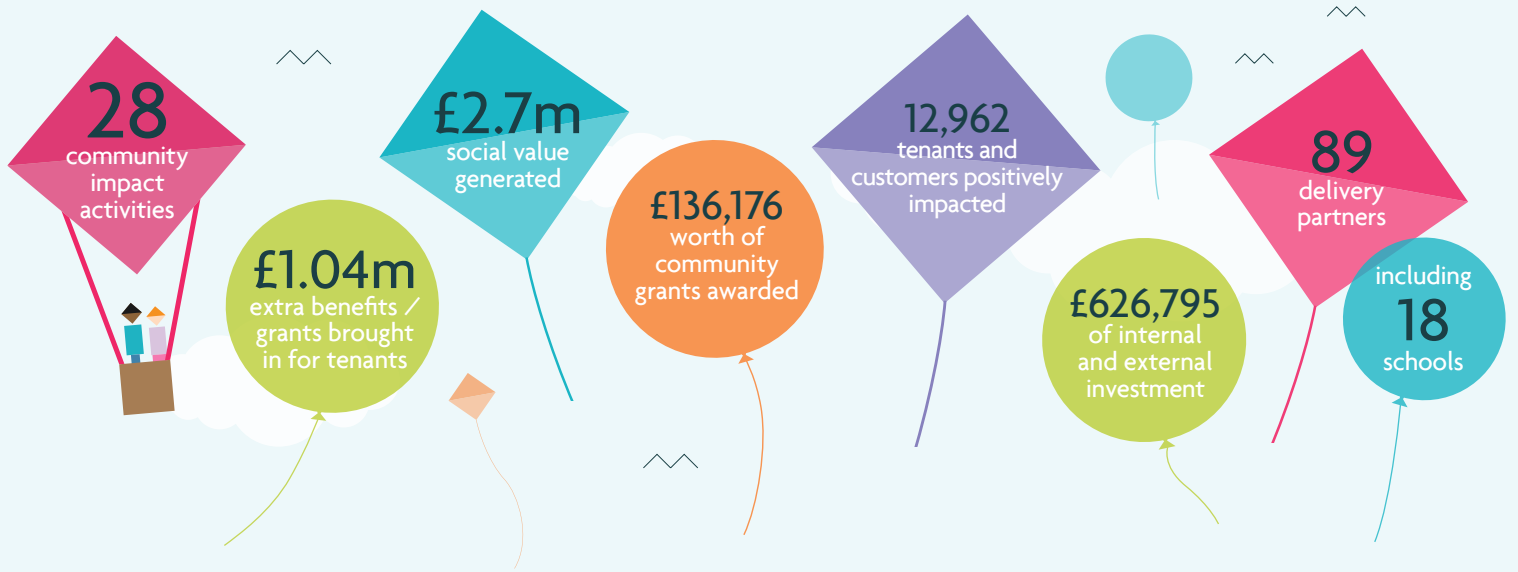


Community Outcome Statement 2017-18

Throughout 2017-18 we worked together with communities and partners on Community Impact Strategy activities to deliver the vision of Improved Lives



HEALTH

228 school pupils learnt how to grow produce and eat healthily

362 school pupils increased their understanding of [dementia](#)

1,896 hours of weekly social inclusion through sheltered scheme activities



520 households had aids and adaptations installed to enable independent living

NEIGHBOURHOOD

527 volunteering hours (staff/contractors)

£18,366 charitable donations (staff)

821 tenancy breaches managed

320 customers [sustained tenancies](#) through 944 interventions (£1 = £7.21 of value delivered)

31 neighbourhoods improved through grounds maintenance

5 disused sites [regenerated](#) with new homes to meet housing need for 180 households

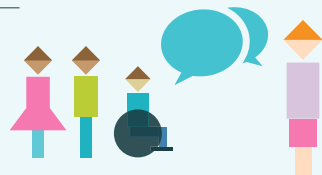


SAFE COMMUNITIES

6,854 hours of [youth engagement](#) through youth clubs reduced youth ASB by 74% (from 92 to 24 incidents)

1,059 ASB reports resolved with local agencies

7 primary school pupils completed a mentoring programme with an 85% improvement in behaviours (from 204 to 31 areas of concern)



EDUCATION & EMPLOYMENT

254 people improved their career prospects through employment pathways



£3.98 of value delivered for each £1 invested through in-house employment initiatives

199 people took up training with 247 qualifications gained

95 people secured a job (including self employment)
